

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE SECTION 91.06

AN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH THE REGULATION OF DOG KENNELS

Findings.

1. The Browns Valley City Council has adopted the Minnesota Basic Code as it has been amended and supplemented to be its city code; and
2. That code permits the City of Browns Valley to regulate the number of dogs that are kept on a particular premises.
3. The Browns Valley City Council believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to modify its Ordinance regulating the number of dogs kept on a particular premises in order to increase the number of dogs allowed.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 91.06(A) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(A) *Definition of kennel.* The keeping of more than three dogs on the same premises, whether owned by the same person or not and for whatever purpose kept, shall constitute a kennel except that a fresh litter of pups may be kept for a period of three months before that keeping shall be deemed to be a kennel.”

2. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 91.06(B) is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(B) *Kennel as a potential nuisance.* Because the keeping of three or more dogs on the same premises may be subject to great abuse, causing discomfort to persons in the area by way of smell, noise, hazard, and general aesthetic depreciation, the keeping of four or more dogs on the premises requires a kennel license in addition to the dog licenses required for each dog. Fees, see §30.11”
