

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 150.07

AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF M.S.A. §462.3593

Findings.

1. On May 12, 2016, M.S.A. §462.3593 was enacted, permitting and regulating temporary family health care dwellings;
2. Subdivision 9 of M.S.A. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations; and
3. The Browns Valley City Council believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to enact an Ordinance opting out of these regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 150.07 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

“150.07 Opt-Out of M.S.A. §462.3593.

Pursuant to authority granted by M.S.A. §462.3593, Sub. 9, the City of Browns Valley hereby opts-out of the requirements of M.S.A. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.


