

RESOLUTION 22-06

**Amended Resolution Switching from Mail-In Balloting to Polling
and Designating the Polling Place for the City of Browns Valley**

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, the Browns Valley City Council had approved a resolution allowing voting to be conducted via mail-in balloting pursuant to Minnesota Statute §204B.45;

WHEREAS, the Browns Valley City Council now desires to cease conducting its elections by mail-in balloting and instead switch back to conducting voting at a designated polling place;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minnesota Statute §204B.16, the City of Browns Valley is required to designate by ordinance or resolution all polling places for each election precinct within the municipal boundary by December 31 of each year;

WHEREAS, the polling places designated in the ordinance or resolution are to be the polling places for elections within the municipal boundary for the following calendar year, unless a change is made;

WHEREAS, the Browns Valley City Council has discussed the designation of the polling place for the City of Browns Valley;

WHEREAS, the Browns Valley City Council designates the meeting room at the Browns Valley Public Library, 15 3rd St. So., in said city, as the polling place for the elections; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Browns Valley agrees that the polling place is:

- Fully accessible
- Large enough to accommodate the election activities
- Free of other non-election activities
- Smoke free
- Liquor free and not next to a liquor service area; and
- Located within the precinct.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Browns Valley is designating the Browns Valley Public Library, 15 3rd St. So., Browns Valley as the polling place for the 2022 elections.
