



Browns Valley Special City Council Meeting Approved Minutes

The regular council meeting of the City of Browns Valley, MN was held in the meeting room of the Public Library. The meeting was called to order at 7:04 a.m. by Mayor Mike Heck

The special meeting was held for the purpose of construction of the public works maintenance building.

Kenny Westbrook and Ken Warren the council's building committee was instructed to receive estimates on constructing a shop building on main street 72x72. Warren and Westbrook were also instructed to contact Gettmans to put a bid for purchase of building. The council did not accept Gettman's bid to purchase the building. No formal action was taken. The question was made do we continue to build at existing location or at the old City Park. Therefore, council discussed about moving location to the old City Park which Roy Merihart surveyed and recommended to have at least a foot above grade of fill brought in before constructions. Hook called League of Minnesota Cities and normal perils would be covered for insurance but the building and items will not be covered under flood insurance.

Serocki informed council that project is totaling over \$175,000 will need to follow competitive bidding law.
