

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 90.18(C)

AN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH ABATEMENT PROCEDURES
IN THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY

Findings.

1. There have been several complaints regarding the storage of junk and/or unlicensed vehicles on properties within the City of Browns Valley, which constitute a nuisance to the public.
2. The existing Ordinance does not contain adequate provisions to deal with junk and/or unlicensed vehicles that would allow the needed abatements to occur in a more timely manner.
3. The Browns Valley City Council believes that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to amend the existing Ordinance dealing with junk vehicles in order to allow better abatement procedures.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **That Section 90.18(C) of Browns Valley City Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:**

“(C) If the junk or unlicensed vehicle is on private property the City Administrator, or his or her designee, may commence an abatement proceeding pursuant to Section 92.23. Items parked or stored in violation of this Section and not abated within the time period prescribed may be removed by the City. The cost of removal by the City shall be calculated and shall be certified to the County Auditor who shall levy said costs as a special assessment against the property from which removed.
